Child Education Society, the apex body of Bal Bharati Public Schools and other institutions of higher education, was set up in the year 1944 during the pre-independence era when the elders thought that Indian Culture, Heritage, Tradition and Ethos must be preserved and conserved. In order to achieve these objectives, it became obligatory for the Society to educate the young people. Thus, the Society was registered under the Societies Act, 1860.

The Child Education Society has witnessed phenomenal growth of institutions run by it in recent years, going up from just one school and a Nursery Teacher Training Institute in 1984 to as many as twenty-four today. Thirteen of these are Project schools in collaboration with the Indian Railways, National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC) and Moser Baer. This is largely the legacy of a towering figure, a visionary, a mover and shaker, the late Mr K.K. Khullar, President of the Society. After his demise in June 2014, the mantle of leadership fell upon the able shoulders of Mr L.R. Channa, an educationist and social worker who has served as Vice President of the Society for almost three decades.

Bal Bharati Public Schools are comprehensive, co-educational English Medium Schools. Hindi enjoys its place of pride as the National Language in its curriculum.

PRIMARY & MIDDLE

Formal teaching of academic subjects such as English, Hindi, Mathematics, Social Studies, General Science & Environment Studies/Social Science is undertaken.

In addition, students learn about music (vocal & instrumental), dance (folk, classical and contemporary) and physical education.

At the Middle level, besides the academic subjects, a third language (Sanskrit/Odia) is taught from class V to VII.

SCHOOL SYSTEM & CO-SCHOLASTIC

PROCTORIAL BOARD

The School Proctorial Board comprises of the Principal, well qualified Staff and Prefects. The Board looks after general discipline in the School.

There is a Students' Council comprising of two representatives from each class that meets regularly to discuss various aspects of discipline and the smooth running of the school.

HOUSE SYSTEM

CLASSROOMS

MULTIPURPOSE HALL

There is a well-equipped Multi-Purpose Hall fitted with good light and sound equipment. A number of student-centred activities are organised in the hall throughout the year.

LIBRARY

The School has a well-equipped Library, which caters to students of Montessori I to Class VII. The School has the well-stocked books and journals to inculcate the habit of good reading amongst our young and inquisitive learners.

COMPUTER LABORATORY

The School has an air-conditioned computer lab equipped with the latest generation of computers and accessories for students.

SCIENCE LABORATORY

The School has a well-equipped Science Lab for the students which facilitates the experimental teaching and learning by doing concept.

GREEN AREA

To discover bio-diversity in a real life science experiments, the school provides lush green area for the growth of mental health of the students. This serves as an opportunity to engage our young learners in exploring beauty of nature.

The School has facilities for:

- Football, cricket, hockey, volleyball, tennis, badminton, table tennis, gymnastic, athletics and many more.
- The Sports Academy provides advanced training by a well-qualified sports teacher.
- A children's park has been laid out for tiny tots.
- Indoor games like carrom board, passing the ball, chess and so on & outdoor games like football, race etc. are a part of sports training.

PRE-SCHOOL AND PRE-PRIMARY

For initial classes, the school has an innovative & fun-filled learning concept where the child is taught with personal attention and care.

Tiny tots work on the work stations & learn by doing.

The education system in Pre-Primary and Pre-School is to prepare the children for the necessary skills required for their social and emotional development along with their future wellbeing. Children benefit from direct personal participation. We provide opportunity for children to develop ideas and experiences based on self-learning atmosphere for better knowledge of the world around them.

- Bal Bharati makes efforts to cater to the holistic development of Pre School children. Hence, the curriculum has been carefully designed using a thematic approach and integrated concepts that follow the basic principles of Development.
- The teaching learning pedagogies developed by the teachers are typically 'play' and 'activity' based with ample scope for creative expressions.
- It's purely been our endeavour to cultivate concepts and dexterity by aligning Bal Bharati's root pedagogy – 'Montessori Apparatus Activities' for development of 'readiness' and 'comprehensive understanding' at the tender age and stage of Pre-School learning.





MEDICAL EXAMINATION & FIRST AID

Every student is examined at least once a year & a medical record is maintained for all the students. The Health Centre in the township is available for medical assistance and services. Besides, the school has the arrangements for instant first aid and help.

TOURS, EXCURSIONS & CAMPS

ADMISSIONS

Pre-School to Class-VII

The Admission procedure for every Academic year commences from 15th January.

1. The applicant can purchase the Form and Prospectus from the School on all working days between 8:00 am to 12:00 pm. In case you wish to meet the Admission Officer, you may visit the school between 8:00am to 1:00pm (working days).
2. The applicant is required to submit the Admission Form in the Office with the set of documents mentioned overleaf.

MODE OF PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEES

Quarterly Fee is to be paid Online/Cheque/Demand Draft. However, at the time of admission the fee is to be paid by a Demand Draft/Cheque in favour of 'Bal Bharati Public School, NTPC Darlipali'.

Fine for late payment of fee :

Rs. 100 for payment made after notified date till the 10th of the 2nd month of quarter.

Rs. 200 for payment made between the 11th of the 2nd month till the 10th of the 3rd month of the quarter.

Rs. 500 for payment made after the 11th of the 3rd month till the last day of the quarter.

*The name of the student will be struck off the rolls if the fee is not paid by the end of the quarter and readmission fee will be charged.
